It is important that your abstract clearly states the purpose of your paper and summarizes the content. Do not use first or second person (I, me, my, we, us, our, you...). Instead use “this paper” or “the authors”.</i>  Font of abstract’s text: <i>Times New Roman, italic, size 13 pt,</i>  <b>Keywords</b> - font Times New Roman bold, size 13 pt), list of keywords in alphabetical order (font Times New Roman, size - 13pt,

<b>Making References in the text</b>	<p>References in the text are given in parentheses including the author's name and year of publication  e.g. (Cai, 2012; Altbah, 2013)</p> <p>if direct quotation is used -the page to which it refers).  e.g. (Cai, 2012: p. 24)</p>
<b>References</b>	<p>Please follow the APA style: <a href="http://www.bibme.org/citation-guide/apa/">http://www.bibme.org/citation-guide/apa/</a></p> <p>Font: Times New Roman, size (size) 13 pt, left aligned, References should be listed alphabetically</p> <p><b>In the list of references should be at least one source with digital object identifier registered (Digital Object Identifier, DOI).</b></p>
